**Bank Check Payment:** Set up City of Platte City as a payee through your bank and let them send your payment to the City. Give your bank 3 to 5 days to get the check to us.

**Automatic Bank Draft:** Your bank can automatically make your payment each month with this option. Fill out application at City Hall along with voided check.

**Pay by mail or in person** at City Hall, 400 Main Street. After hours drop box on Fourth Street

### SIDEWALK REPAIR COST SHARE PROGRAM
