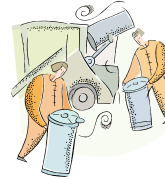

**2014 Spring Clean-Up
 April 22, 23, 24, & 25**

Our annual spring clean-up will be here soon! Large and bulky items will be picked up on your regular trash pick-up day; please have items out at the curb by 6:30 a.m.

The following items will be picked up free of charge:



- ◆ Brush and small limbs (cut to 4' lengths and bundled)
- ◆ Yard waste – leaves and grass clippings (bagged in paper bags only)
- ◆ Tires (limit of 4 per household)
- ◆ Appliances
- ◆ Furniture

Please note that the City **cannot** accept building materials (i.e. lumber, sheetrock, plaster, concrete, siding materials), carpet, insulation or roofing material.

Items not out on your regular pick-up day will not be considered part of the free service, will be picked up only at the resident's request, and regular bulky item pick-up fees will be charged. If you have questions, please contact Public Works at 816-858-4815.

IMPROVED BILL PAY OPTIONS

Platte City has updated its Bank Bill Pay/Electronic Payment Option: Check your settings if you use your bank's on line bill pay system. The City's billing system now supports fully electronic payments. Changing your settings to electronic payment will reduce period between your approval and the bank's payment.

The following payment options are also remain available:

- **Credit or Debit Card** (phone, in person or on-line) : convenience fee applies
- **Bank Bill Pay System:** Use your bank's on line bill pay system: (Check and update settings as needed)
- **Automatic Bank Draft:** Set up automatic bank draft for each month. Apply in person at City Hall
- **Mail in payments or pay in person at City Hall**
- **City Hall Drop Box:** Drop payments in Utility Bill drop box on Fourth Street next to City Hall.
