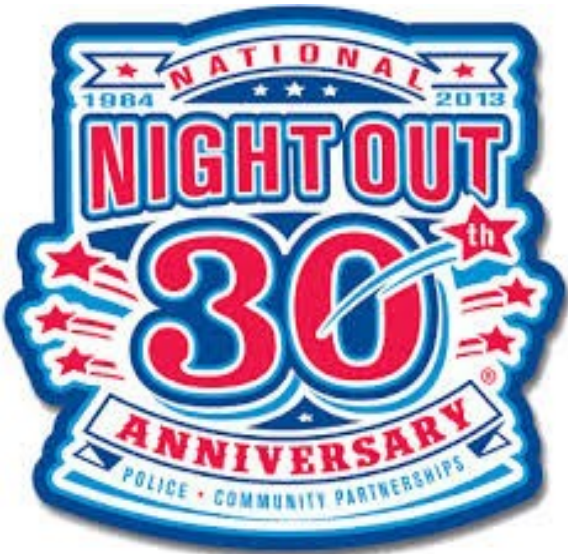

If it has wheels and can be licensed for use on a public street, it should be parked or stored on a hard surface (asphalt, concrete, etc). Grass and gravel do not count.
