SOLID WASTE STORAGE

B. The occupant or owner of every dwelling unit and of every institutional, commercial, industrial, agricultural or business establishment shall place all solid waste to be collected in proper solid waste containers, except as otherwise provided herein, and shall maintain such solid waste containers and the area surrounding them in a clean, neat and sanitary condition at all times.

C. Residential solid waste shall be stored in containers of not less than fifteen (15) gallons nor more than twenty (20) gallons in nominal capacity. Containers shall be leak proof, waterproof and fitted with a fly tight lid and shall be properly covered at all times except when depositing waste therein or removing the contents thereof. The containers shall have handles, bails or other suitable lifting devices or features. Containers shall be of a type originally manufactured for residential solid waste with tapered sides for easy emptying. They shall be of lightweight and sturdy construction. The weight of any individual container and contents shall not exceed sixty (60) pounds. Galvanized metal containers or rubber, fiberglass or plastic containers which do not become brittle in cold weather may be used. Disposable solid waste containers with suitable frames or containers as approved by the Director may also be used for storage of residential solid waste.

Special Item Pickup: Items that are not picked up with normal trash (example: appliances, tires, yard waste, mattress etc.) are picked up on Monday's, but requests must be phoned in by Friday before 4 p.m. (all yard waste must be placed in paper bags).

Tires: \$ 5.00 for each passenger car tire
\$15.00 for each truck, tractor, or unusually large tire
\$10.00 for rims up to seventeen inches in diameter
\$30.00 for rims over seventeen inches in diameter
\$15.00 for items which include, but not limited to:
Furniture, bed springs, water heaters, and lawn mowers
\$25.00 for items which include, but not limited to:
Mattresses, console TV's, and heating units
\$48.00 for items which include, but not limited to:
Appliances and air conditioning units that contain Freon

Rates for items not listed above, will be determined by the Public Works Department

Yard Waste Removal:

\$15.00 for up to twelve (12) bags of yard waste (must be in paper bags)

Seasonal yard waste \$84.00 for season April-November

Yard waste will **only** be picked up April-November and must be placed in paper bags

Dumpster purchase: \$ 640.00 3 yard purchased from City*
\$ 960.00 6 yard purchased from City*
*Dumpsters do not have to be purchased from the City, but must fit onto our trucks, please contact the Public Works department prior to purchasing from another agency to confirm size.

The holiday's listed above are also observed by the refuse department, therefore if your trash service day falls on a holiday it will be picked up on the next business day.

Recycling Program

Residential curbside recycling (This service is picked up on the same day as trash service and is purely voluntary)

A 24hr 7 days a week drop off recycling site is located at 108 Paxton (Public Works Facility).

Items accepted:

Plastics: Any food or Household container which has a number 1 or 2 on the bottom or side.*

Tin: Food containers such as soup, vegetable, fruit and juice containers, etc

Newspaper: Newspapers including inserts

Magazines: All types of slick paper included in magazine or catalogs

Aluminum: All aluminum and soft drink cans

Glass: Clear, amber, & green beverage and food containers**

* The City **cannot** accept any automotive product containers or household hazardous material.

** The following glass products **cannot** be accepted milky white glass, window glass, plate glass, light bulbs, crystal or stoneware.

Frequently Requested Information

Water

- Platte City water is purchased from Kansas City
- Water Hardness is 7 to 10 grains per gallon (Medium Hardness)
- In home water is typically used for:
 - 40% Toilet Flushing
 - 32% Bathing & Showering
 - 14% Laundry
 - 6% Dishwashing
 - 5% Cooking & Drinking
 - 3% Bathroom sink

- A quick check for a leaking stool is to place a few drops of food coloring into the tank of the stool, let sit without flushing the stool for about 5 minutes if color can be seen in the bowl of the stool your stool has a leak.
- Water wasted per month at 60 psi water pressure:
 - 1/16" can leak 24,667 gallons of water
 - 1/8" can leak 98,667 gallons of water
 - 3/16" can leak 222,000 gallons of water
 - 1/4" can leak 393,833 gallons of water
