SNOW CLEARING TIPS:



Platte City's top priority in a snowstorm is plowing snow routes, which may require several trips down the same route. Snow plowed from roads could block private driveways for some time. Due to limited time and resources during a snow event, plows can only clear private driveways at the request of local emergency officials.

To **reduce** the amount of snow that may block your driveway, shovel an open area along the shoulder at the entrance (see illustration to the right). Plow blades will then push snow into the area just before your driveway and leave a much smaller amount of snow in front of your driveway.

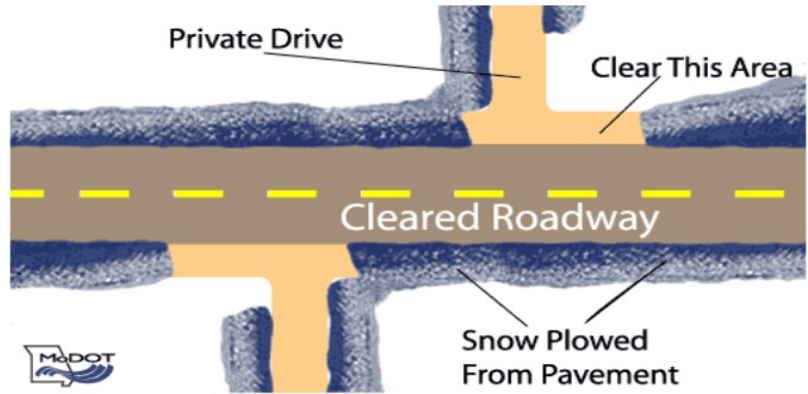

Emergency Snow Routes

The City reminds residents of the Emergency Snow Routes that will go into effect when winter weather conditions warrant. The Emergency Snow Routes were established to benefit and protect the public. Your cooperation is essential in keeping our streets open during these times.

Platte City ordinances prohibit parking between the hours of 7:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. on streets designated as Emergency Snow Routes when ice or one or more inches of snow has accumulated. Cars may be parked on Main Street except between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.

Streets designated as Emergency Snow Routes are as follows: *Main Street, Fourth Street, Vine Street east of Fourth Street, Paxton Street from First Street to Second Street, Wallingford Drive, O'Rourke Drive, Spring Street, Mill Street, Academy Street, Maple Drive from Fourth Street to Wells Road, Wells Road from Maple Drive to Hale Avenue, Hale Avenue north of Wells Road, Bello Mondo Drive, Marshall Road and Second Street from Main Street to Academy Street*

Your cooperation during winter weather conditions is appreciated to assist in keeping our streets open for travel.
